THE NEW MODERATED PARISH OF THE FORMER REDHILL DEANERY

Bishop Richard has written to the parishes of the old Redhill deanery to confirm that in the Diocesan Pastoral Plan the parishes of Caterham, Oxted and Warlingham, and Redhill, Reigate & Merstham will in due course become one moderated parish. The previous parishes of the old Epsom deanery will likewise become another moderated parish. This is to replicate the plan across the Diocese to form 11 parishes from the existing 70+ parishes we currently have. Bishop Richard intends to appoint Fr Tony Bridson to be the moderator for this area in East Surrey when the new parish eventually comes into existence. As a first step on that path, the Diocesan pastoral planning team will be meeting with the clergy sometime in the autumn.
