#### High Weald Walking Festival, Worth Estate, Thursday 12 and Saturday 14 September

Worth Abbey Pilgrims will be supporting the High Weald Festival again this year by offering a number of guided walks through the Worth Estate, celebrating the joy and beauty of Worth. The walks were incredibly popular last year and so this year they will offer 2 walks on Thursday 12 September, departing at 10.30am and 2pm promptly guided by Fr Patrick. These moderate-level walks will depart from the Abbey Church Piazza and will take approximately 1.5-2 hours depending on the group speed. The route is 4.6km and will include some muddy and uphill areas so sensible footwear is a must. Dogs on leads and children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. They will also be offering a guided walk on Saturday 16 September from Balcombe Rail Station to Worth and return, departing promptly at 10.30am and returning at 4pm. This is a leisurely route over 7km and will include uphill and some stiles. This walk is not suitable for children or dogs. Bring a picnic to enjoy in the beautiful surroundings or enjoy refreshments which will be available to purchase on the Piazza at Worth Abbey.
